The Mexican Cycling Federation, the State Association of Cycling of Aguascalientes, the State Government as well as the Sports Institute of the State of Aguascalientes invite all the National Federations of the American Continent affiliated to the Pan American Cycling Confederation (COPACI), to participate in the XXIII Pan-American Mountain Bike Championship, in the modalities of (XCO, XCR, XCE), to be held between 03 and 06 April 2019, in El Ocote - Aguascalientes - Mexico

PLACE OF COMPETITION

The XXIII PAN AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP OF MOUNTAIN BIKE will take place in the OCOTE community area, in the Municipality of Aguascalientes, Aguascalientes, Mexico. Aguascalientes, is a state that is located in the geographic center of the Mexican Republic, 485 km from Mexico City, known as the World Cycling Capital, since it has the Velodrome that has generated the most records in its history. short history, the city has as capital of the state the municipality of the same name Aguascalientes, whose name is related to the springs that existed from their origins where springs sprout with water at high temperatures, is a state of the smallest in the country, however of the most productive whose main activity is the manufacture of automobiles, although in the last years the agricultural vocation has been resumed where the production of vegetables, fruits like the Guava and the Grape predominate, with an average altitude above sea level of 1888 meters and a dry and stable climate makes it a very friendly place for the development of sporting events, its architecture is influenced by the colony and the post colonial era, little by little modernity is present in buildings and urban decoration, Aguascalientes is recognized by the National Fair of San Marcos that takes place every year and whose origins were the commercialization of original products of the region, transforming now into one of the main sources of income for the tourism and food industry, where more than seven million visitors attend in each edition in 22 days of festivities.

Aguascalientes is an area of the Mexican Altiplano, in the capital is concentrated 80% of the predominantly young population, has large hotel tourism infrastructure, international airport and great urban connectivity; highlighting in the local architecture the Cathedral, the palaces of state and municipal government, the excedra and the squares of the jacarandas in the historic center, a little beyond this point the Garden of San Marcos, the Aguascalientes Museum, the Encino Neighborhood , the Park of the three centuries where the railroad workshops were housed at the beginning of the 20th century, a site that has become a place for the promotion of culture, sport and health, the Alameda, the Purísima district, among others .

Average temperature: 19-21 ° C

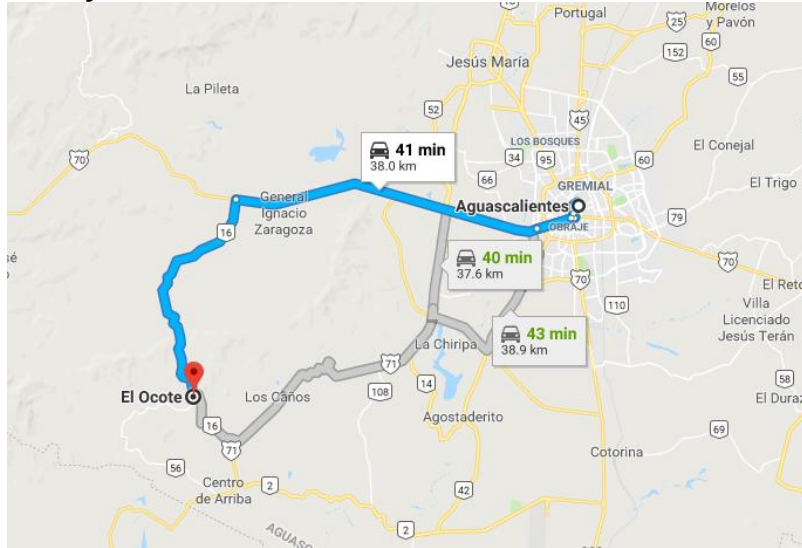

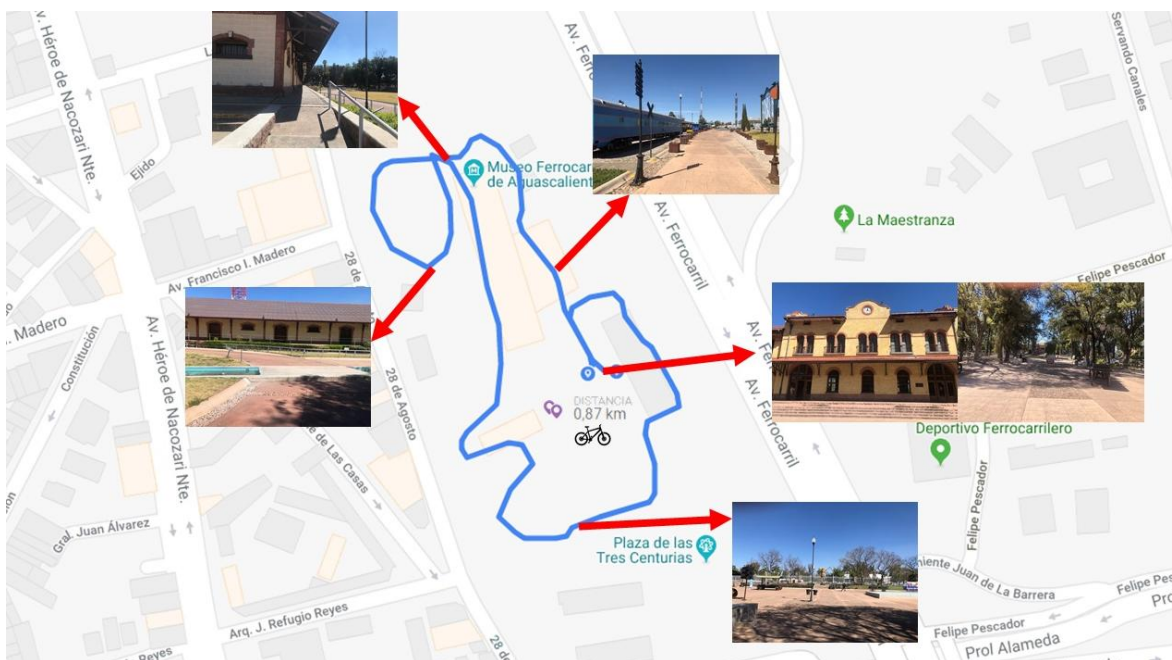
CIRCUITO CROSS COUNTRY

REQUIREMENTS TO PARTICIPATE

- 1. U.C.I. License 2019 updated the country it represents, Identity Document or passport and International Medical Assistance Insurance.**
- 2. Participating countries must send the pre-registration and registration forms of the Athletes and delegates**
- 3. The number of Athletes that each country can register in ALL categories is free**
- 4. The registration fee will be US \$ 50.00, for each participant. The registration expiration date is 03/25/201**

5. For the transfer of delegations from the airport to the official hotels of the event, each Federation must send the number of athletes, delegates and mechanics, indicating the date, flight number and time of arrival at the airport of the city of Aguascalientes, to take them to the Real Plaza Hotel Aguascalientes, until the 03/27/2019.

6. The organization **will NOT** be responsible for the reception of delegations for transport and reception at the airport, to those representations that do not send the information requested in the previous point.

7. Only one arrival will be received by the Official Delegation.

8. The organization will provide official transport of the Real Plaza Hotel - El Ocote - Hotel Real Plaza, for training and competition days, at specific times given by the Pan American Organization 2019

9. Official representations must contemplate Regulation U.C.I. regarding the representative clothing of each country.

10. The organization will provide first aid for accidents, to all the delegations present. All athletes must have a Medical Insurance and Accidents.

11. Send, within the deadlines established in the Event Schedule, the PRE Registration and Final Enrollment Confirmation forms, complete with; U.C.I. Code and Document Number or Passport.

12. The Disciplinary Regulation U.C.I. will be applied, from the arrival of the Delegations and until the end of the competitions.

13. The organization will not be responsible for the cancellation of the services of HOSPEDAJE, ALIMENTACION, TELEFONO; FAX; INTERNET; LAUNDRY; ROOM SERVICES; PUB; TRANSPORTATION, ETC ...

14. Each Delegation must be provided with the National Anthem and Flag.
