#### **Place and date:**

The Mexican Cycling Federation AC, is pleased to invite all national cycling federations affiliated with the Pan American Cycling Confederation to participate in the Pan American Junior Track and Road Championship, which will take place from July 2 to July 7. of this year, in the state of Jalisco, Mexico.

#### **Lodging**

The Organization of the Pan American Junior Track and Road 2019, will provide lodging and meals with the reception of equipment from dinner on Sunday, June 30 to breakfast on July 8, at La Fayette Hotel, Av. La Paz # 2055, CP 44140, Guadalajara, Jalisco, Tel: 044 33 36 69 50 50.

The Organizing Committee of the Pan American Championships, will provide each delegation with support from the receipt of equipment on June 30, considering accommodation, food and internal transportation until the July 8 exit for a maximum of 22 people, of them 10 male athletes, 8 ladies and 4 managers.

The Airport in the City of Guadalajara is the Miguel Hidalgo y Costilla International Airport.

The organization is not responsible for the cancellation of extra services such as: telephone calls, internet, laundry, room and bar services as well as transportation and food not provided by the organizing committee.



## **TRANSPORT:**

The organization has arranged transportation services from the hotel headquarters to the velodrome and return to the hotel.

Each National Federation will have as limit until June 10 to send their numerical confirmation and until June 18 to send the registration, in the official format, as well as their arrival itineraries for the coordination of the reception of equipment and power provide transportation support and travel to the hotel provided by the Organization.

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for the reception, transport and reception outside Guadalajara, in addition to those national federations that do not send the information of the itineraries, number of delegation members and number of bicycles and that they bring.

One (1) only reception by official delegation at the airport or bus terminal of the City of Guadalajara.
