**Place and date:**

The Bolivian Cycling Federation, with the support of the Government of the Plurinational State of Bolivia through the Ministry of Sport, is pleased to invite cyclists from their country to participate in the Pan-American Elite Track Championship, which will be held from September 4 to 8, 2019 in the Velodrome of the Sports Training Center (CEFED), Cochabamba.

**Characteristics of the Velodrome:**

- ❖ Track Length 250 m
- ❖ Track width. 7.00 m
- ❖ Infrastructure: Cover
- ❖ The Track Surface is made of wood
- ❖ Located in La Tamborada, Cochabamba

**General information:**

- ❖ Average temperature: oscillates between 5 ° C minimum and 27 ° C. maximum in Cochabamba.
- ❖ Altitude: 2558 m s. n. m.

**Lodging**

The Organization of the Pan-American Elite Track Championship will provide accommodation and food support from September 2 at the hotel of the Sports Training Center (CEFED) Cochabamba which is 50 meters from the Velodrome and until the breakfast of 9 September. The reception of teams can be on September 2 and 3, for a maximum of 22 people, of them 10 male athletes, 8 ladies and 4 managers.

**TRANSPORT:**

The organization has arranged transportation services from the airport-hotel-airport. Each National Federation will have as limit until August 15 of this year, to confirm numerically the numerical participation and until August 20 to send the registration in the corresponding formats,



as well as their arrival itineraries for the coordination of the reception of teams and be able to provide transportation support and travel to the headquarters hotel, provided by the Organization.

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for the reception, transport and reception of those national federations that do not send the information of the itineraries, number of delegation members and number of bicycles that they bring.

- ❖ Four (4) UCI International UCI Commissaires or UCI Elite Nationals appointed by the Pan American Cycling Confederation (COPACI).
- ❖ The Bolivian Cycling Federation (FMC) will appoint the 12 Commissioners for the formation of the College of Commissioners

### ANTIDOPING CONTROL:

One (1) anti-doping inspector will be appointed by the International Cycling Union (UCI). It will be done according to the current regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI).
