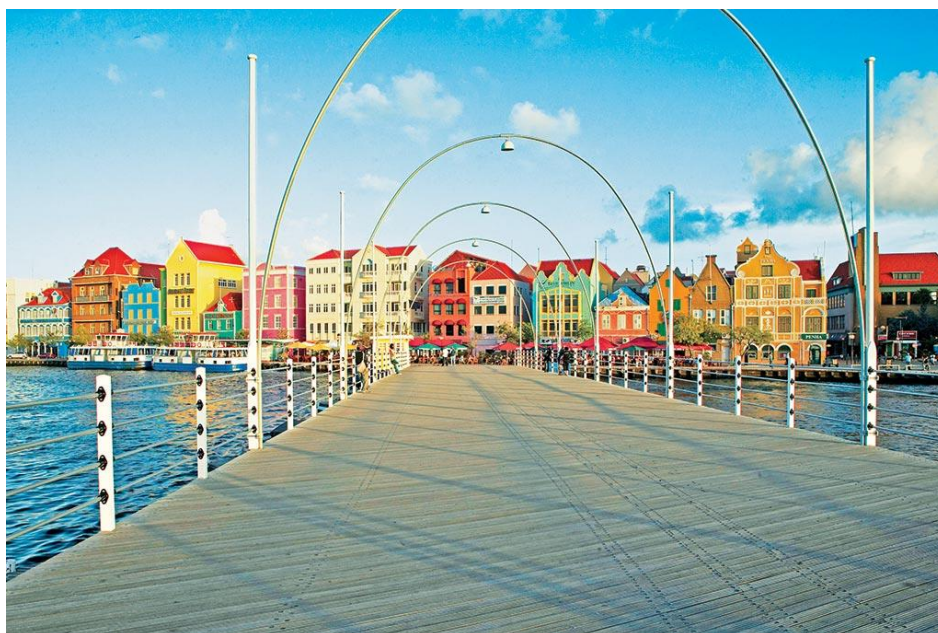

1. Introduction

The Curaçao Cycling Federation, the Ministry of Sports, Cultures, Educations and Science, and the Olympic Committee (FDOK), are proud to invite you to participate at the second Caribbean BMX Championship 2019 to be held on October 27th at the beautiful island of Curaçao.

3. Location

Track's address: Chuchubiweg 10, Damacor.

The track is in the same street as our National Zoo.

4. Rules and Regulations

The competition will be held according to the international rules and regulations of UCI.

The Selections of the participating countries must be made up of a maximum of 3 athletes (1 woman & 2 man + 1 Assistants in the following way:

Total of 2 riders of the Elite/ Junior Men and a total of 1 rider of the Elite/Junior Women. * The host country has the right to register a total of 4 Elite/Junior Men and a total of 2 Elite/Junior Women.

The participation is mandatory for **1 National delegate (Chef d'Equipe) and 1 National coach.**

Elite Men and Junior Men will race against in one Elite Class, as well Elite Women with Junior Women; the final results will be in one class based on the results summary.

Riders will get the ranking points that correspond with the place in the separate results and will be awarded medals that correspond with the place in results.

All registered riders have to do 3 qualification motos to qualify for the next stage of the event.

The organization will not be responsible for the coverage of extra services such as: telephone calls, internet services, laundry, room and bar service, transportation and food not provided by the organization.

5. Registration

The registration deadline for foreign riders is Friday 25th of October 2019.

The registration will be made with the official format which will be received only until Friday October 25th 2019, sent to the organization by email: info@curacaocyclingfederation.com and wmcoffi@gmail.com

6. Registration fee

Championship class: US \$ 50, 00

Payment in cash at the rider's confirmation at the office at the Track

7. Classes

The race is open to any rider from any Caribbean country with a regular national license, in compliance with the UCI regulations. The classes allowed to compete are the following:

Joined Class Junior Men/Elite Men ages; 17 years and older (born in 2002);

Joined Class Junior Women/Elite Women ages: 17 years and older (born in 2002).

8. Number plates

Every rider of Curaçao must use their personal number plates used during the regular Curacao Cycling Federation competitions. Foreign riders could use their personal frontal number plates.

9. Awards

Championship Class

1st Place : Gold medal + Trophy

2nd Place : Silver medal

3rd Place : Bronze medal

Money prize according UCI

10. STRIDER RACE

Immediately after the opening ceremony, Strider races will start.

These Strider balance bikes without pedals will be for children aged from 2 years till 5 years

12. Team Manager

The organization will provide ID cards / passes for two persons (Team Manager and assistant) for every National Federation. The Team Manager's area is located inside the track between the third and last straight beside the finish line. **No access to other place inside the track is allowed.**

13. Parking

All the cars must be left outside the track's fence in the dedicated parking area. No motor vehicles will be allowed inside the track, with the exception of ambulance.
