# CHARACTERISTICS OF THE VELODROME





## VICENTE ALEJO CHANCAY VELODROME

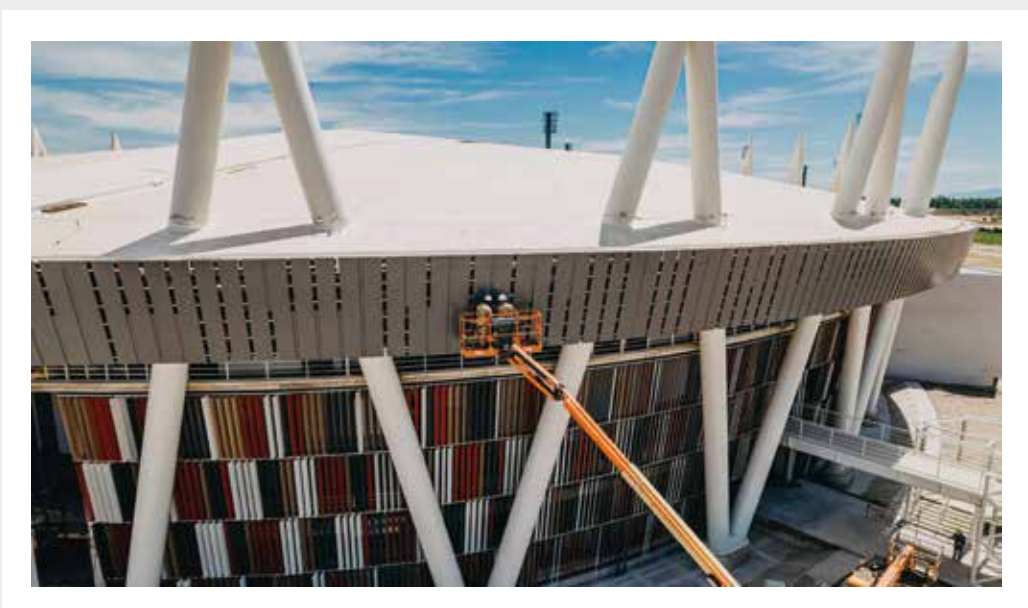
We continue to build in San Juan the largest indoor velodrome in South America. This infrastructure and avant-garde mega project is currently 75% complete. The total capacity for spectators will be around six thousand seated persons. In addition, it has been approved by the International Cycling Union (UCI) and will be equipped with all the necessary amenities and services.

The velodrome is the kick-off of the Sports City. It will be an area of more than 50 hectares, that will unite the practice of various sports disciplines. In addition to the velodrome, the complex shall house multidisciplinary, multi-sports micro-stadiums and residences for high-performance athletes.

The imposing structure has an oval-shaped roof. And a surface area of more than 15,300 m<sup>2</sup>. And the square meters of the building itself will be 26,700. This structure is supported by columns weighing more than 36 tons.

The circuit will be 250 meters long, with a width of 7 meters, with superelevations and slopes of with a minimum of 13.2 degrees and a maximum of 42.5 degrees plus a safety track 4 meters wide, entirely made of wood.

This jewel of San Juan is also being built with international supervision. We are referring to Peter Junek, a renowned track builder in the world, who has taken part in the construction of more than 25 structures.

Dear delegations, from the organization of the Pan American Track Cycling Championship - San Juan 2023 we inform the following:

The following alternatives are available to arrive by air at our headquarters:

1) San Juan has the Domingo Faustino Sarmiento Airport. It is located 14 km southeast of the capital city and 20 km from the Vicente Alejo Chancay indoor velodrome. This The airport only receives domestic flights, therefore, it is not international. If you choose this option, contemplate that they will have at least one layover at the Aeroparque Jorge Newbery Airport or Ezeiza Airport, both in Buenos Aires.

2) Mendoza has the El Plumerillo International Airport. It is located 169 km to the south of the capital of San Juan and 161 km south of the Vicente Alejo Chancay indoor velodrome. Yeah opt for this option, after arriving in Mendoza they must transfer by land, since there is no availability of flights from Mendoza to San Juan.

# TOURISM



# THEATER OF THE BICENTENNIAL



It is one of the most important cultural spaces in the country. Its modern design and the exceptional technological and acoustic conditions of the main hall place it at the level of the best stages in the world, allowing the presentation of large-scale shows.

Its architecture is minimalist in style, the building has the appearance of a solid block,

with a predominance of San Juan travertine marble. At the center is the imposing main hall covered in Corten steel, evoking the earthy color of the San Juan mountains. During the guided tour you will be able to visit different spaces and learn amazing details about the architecture and acoustics.

# ISCHIGUALASTO PROVINCIAL PARK



Ischigualasto Provincial Park is located northeast of the city of San Juan, 265 km down the National Route 150 and 330 km down the Provincial Route 510.

The rugged landscape, its geological formations and its paleontological richness contribute to the value and importance of this World Heritage Site.

Among sandstones and clays, wind and water have sculpted surprising shapes known by popular names such as: El Gusano (the worm), El Hongo (the fungus), La Esfinge (the sphinxes), La Cancha de Bochas, El Valle Pintado (the Painted Valley), among others.

The numerous findings of animal and plant fossils allow us to learn about one of the most interesting chapters in the history of the Earth. Geologically and paleontologically, the area represents the first of the periods into which the Mesozoic Era is divided: The Triassic Period. Here, the oldest dinosaur in the world has been found (230 million years old), as well as a carnivorous and an herbivorous specimen which account for the most primitive in the world.

# DIFUNTA CORREA



The place is located in the department of Cauce. It is a story of faith that moves crowds, transmitted orally from generation to generation, the Difunta Correa is a popular devotion appealing to persons from all the provinces of Argentina and other countries.

Deolinda Correa lived in San Juan in the first half of the 19th century. Shortly after becoming a mother, her husband was recruited due to the struggles between the Unitarians and the Federals.

With few provisions and her baby in her arms, Deolinda tried to cross the San Juan desert in search of her husband who was imprisoned in La Rioja. She died of thirst, but her son survived by feeding at her breast. With the passing of time and after having performed miracles for muleteers and travelers, it became a place visited by those who come to make a request or leave an offering - water bottles, candles, patents, small houses - to the Difunta Correa.

# PAMPA DEL LEONCITO



Pampa del Leoncito is a unique place in the world, only 40 kilometers from Barreal. It is a strange plain, fourteen kilometers long and five kilometers wide, where millions of years ago a huge lake dried up. Today, a radiant white surface makes us feel as if we were walking through a lunar landscape.

There is not a single bush there, only a smooth ground with perfectly reproduced pentagon-shaped cracks.

For those who know about the subject, besides being a beautiful landscape, Barreal is perhaps the best track of carrovelismo in the world. This is a fascinating sport that gets the wind speed through a hand glider which manipulation allows to pull a car. It is enough to look at a photo to understand it.

# CIRCUITO SAN JUAN VILLICUM



Located in the department of Albardón, the 4,254-meter layout has constant ups and downs along the route, artificially generated with a soil movement of more than 700,000 m<sup>3</sup>. It also has two alternative circuits of 3,500 and 2,500 meters in length.

The track has 68,256 m<sup>2</sup> of asphalt surface, as well as 8,708 m<sup>2</sup> of guardrail around the perimeter to contain the vehicles. At the same time, the track has 15 hectares of grass around it.



# Punta Negra Dam



It is one of the most requested sites by tourists in recent years, thanks to its natural beauty and incredible landscapes.

The dam has a great infrastructure and variety of tourist activities to enjoy throughout the year,

among them are: food stands, catamaran rides, pedal boats, kayaks, lessons and experiences of stand up paddle, diving and snorkeling. In addition to sports excursions with trekking, running and cycling among others.

## NATIONAL CURRENCY
