The VELO Sports Center is a 100,000 square foot, \$15 million specially designed 250- meter indoor wood bicycle racing track. The VELO Sports Center is also a part of Dignity Health Sports Park’s partnership with the USOPC as an Official U.S. Olympic Training Site and is a home track to USA Cycling’s national track cycling program. The VELO Sports Center hosts training and international competitions for the world’s elite cyclists, as well as classes open to the public, at any skill level.

As America’s largest indoor velodrome, VELO sports center is committed to the growth of the sport of cycling. Youth, beginner, intermediate, and advanced training programs are available to those curious about cycling or for any aspiring Olympic and World Championship athletes.

## SAFESPORT

Athlete safety and well-being is of the utmost importance to USA Cycling. To help create and foster a safe environment that is free from misconduct and abuse at all USA Cycling events, please review USA Cycling's Safe Sport Program Policies, including reporting requirements and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP). All Participants at USA Cycling sanctioned events must abide by these policies.

## PROHIBITED CONDUCT

All Participants at this event are expected to refrain from engaging in Prohibited Conduct as defined by the US Center for SafeSport Code. Prohibited Conduct includes but is not limited to the following: sexual misconduct, emotional misconduct, physical misconduct, bullying, harassment, hazing, and violations of the MAAPP.

## MAAPP

These policies have been adopted by USA Cycling to establish clear boundaries between participants in cycling and to reduce isolated one-on-one interactions between minors and adults in cycling and apply during all USA Cycling events, including before, during and returning from the event: One-on-One Interactions; Meeting & Training Sessions; Athletic Training Modalities; Locker Rooms; Transportation; Lodging; Electronic Communications.

## REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Adult Participants are required to report violations of USA Cycling's Safe Sport Program, including violations of the MAAPP. The mandatory reporting requirements apply to Adult Participants, but USA Cycling encourages anyone who becomes aware of or experiences misconduct or abuse to report those allegations via the links provided below. While USA Cycling is committed to providing a safe environment for all participants, the organization can't address behaviors or problems it is unaware of, so your engagement in reporting is instrumental in ensuring safety for all.

# EL CENTRO DEPORTIVO VELO ESTÁ UBICADO EN EL COMPLEJO DEL PARQUE DEPORTIVO DIGNITY HEALTH DE 125 ACRES EN LA CIUDAD DE CARSON, CA.

El VELO Sports Center es un velódromo cubierto, de madera de 100.000 pies cuadrados y valorada en 15 millones de dólares, de 250 metros de longitud, especialmente diseñada. El VELO Sports Center también forma parte de la asociación de Dignity Health Sports Park con el U.S. Comité Olímpico y Paraolímpico como sitio oficial de entrenamiento olímpico de los Estados Unidos y es la pista sede del programa nacional de ciclismo en pista de USA Cycling. El Centro Deportivo VELO alberga entrenamientos y competiciones internacionales para ciclistas élités del mundo, así como clases abiertas al público, en cualquier nivel.

Como el velódromo cubierto más grande en los Estados Unidos, el centro deportivo VELO está comprometido con el crecimiento del deporte del ciclismo. ## DEPORTE SEGURO (SAFESPORT)

La seguridad y el salud de los atletas son de máxima importancia para USA Cycling. Para ayudar a crear y fomentar un ambiente seguro, libre de mala conducta y abuso en todos los eventos de USA Cycling, el favor de revisar las reglas de la programa SafeSport de USA Cycling, incluidos los requisitos de presentación de informes y las reglas de prevención de abuso de atletas menores. Todos los participantes en eventos autorizados por USA Cycling deben cumplir con estas reglas.

## CONDUCTA PROHIBIDA

Se espera que todos los participantes en este evento se abstengan de participar en conductas prohibidas según lo define en el Código del Centro para SafeSport de EE. UU. La conducta prohibida incluye, entre otras, lo siguiente: conducta sexual inapropiada, mala conducta emocional, mala conducta física, intimidación, acoso, novatadas y violaciones de las reglas relativas a los atletas Juniors.

## REGLAS RELATIVAS A LOS ATLETAS JUNIORS

Estas reglas han sido adoptadas por USA Cycling para establecer límites claros entre los participantes en el ciclismo, y para reducir las interacciones individuales aisladas entre menores y adultos en el ciclismo y se aplican durante todos los eventos de USA Cycling, incluso antes, durante y al regresar del evento: Interacciones Uno a Uno; Sesiones de Reuniones y Entrenamiento; Modalidades de Entrenamiento Atlético; Vestuarios; Transporte; Alojamiento; Comunicaciones Electrónicas.

## LOS REQUISITOS DE INFORMACIÓN

Los participantes adultos deben informar las infracciones del Programa de SafeSport de USA Cycling, incluidas las infracciones relativas a los Juniors. Los requisitos de denuncia obligatorios se aplican a los participantes adultos, pero USA Cycling alienta a cualquier persona que tenga conocimiento sobre conducta mala o abuso a denunciar esas acusaciones a través de los enlaces que se proporcionan por abajo. USA Cycling se compromete a proporcionar un ambiente seguro para todos los participantes, pero la organización no puede arreglar comportamientos o problemas que desconoce, así que su participación en la presentación de informes es fundamental para garantizar la seguridad de todos.
