2. The City

Asunción is one of the oldest cities in South America and was, for a long time, the main city of the Río de la Plata basin. Juan de Salazar de Espinosa arrived at a Guaraní village and founded a fort there on August 15, 1537 (the day of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary into heaven). Because of this, he named it Nuestra Señora Santa María de la Asunción. The city became a strategic point for the foundation of more than 70 cities across South America, earning it the title "Mother of Cities."

3. Currency

The currency of the Republic of Paraguay is the **Guaraní**, with an exchange rate of approximately **7,900 per 1 US Dollar** (as of today's date).

4. Lenguage

One of the most distinctive features of Paraguayan culture is the coexistence of **Spanish and Guaraní**, both of which are the country's official languages. The mixture of these languages is known as **Jopará**.





Ilustración 39. Temperatura media mensual y valores extremos mensuales de la máxima y mínima.













6. Voltage and Standard Plug

• Voltage: 220 V

• Frequency: 50 Hz

• Plug Type: C

In Paraguay, the standard voltage is 220 V, and the frequency is 50 Hz. The plugs and sockets used are Type C.

In the following images, you can see the types of plugs (pins and sockets).

The need for an adapter or converter depends on the voltage, frequency, and plugs used in your country. The plugs used in Paraguay are Type C.

11.Information for Teams

11.1 Event Commissaires:

One (1) International Technical Delegate appointed by the International Cycling Union (UCI).

One (1) UCI International Commissaire appointed by the International Cycling Union (UCI).

Three (3) UCI International or UCI Elite National Commissaires appointed by the Pan American Cycling Confederation (COPACI).

The Paraguayan Cycling Federation (FPC) will appoint 10 Commissaires to form the Commissaire Panel.

11.2 UCI Categories

Elite Men and Women - U23 (according to Article 3.2.001, Junior riders in their last year / 2007 are allowed to participate).











11.3 Registrations

Registrations must be completed using the online format provided by the organization through the National Federations. Once the form is filled out, it must be printed, signed, scanned, and sent in PDF format to the email address: panamericano@fpc.org.py

There will be no cost for registration in these competitions.

The deadline for numerical registrations is February 28, 2025, and for nominal registrations, it is March 16, 2025. Late registrations will be accepted until just before the start of the technical meeting.

11.4 License and Insurance

Riders must present their updated licenses issued by their respective National Federation at the time of confirming their registration.

All athletes must provide proof of their International Health Insurance. Delegates will be responsible for submitting the documentation when formalizing the registrations.

11.5Awards:

Trophies will be awarded for 1st to 3rd place based on the points in the final, for both categories, as well as the champion's jersey for both genders.

12. Regulations

The competition will be held according to the rules of the International Cycling Union, with the program prepared by COPACI.

13. Medical Attention

- Primary care on the track
- Transfer to the official clinic or another facility at no cost
- Official Clinic: To be determined

14. Doping Control

Doping control will be conducted according to the current regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI).

15. Accreditations

Each delegation will be provided with the following accreditations:

- Federation President and/or Team Manager
- Armbands for the riders











- Passes for the 3 delegates from each country
- Press Pass (1 per country)








16.4 Airport
