The City

Santiago de Chile is located in the Metropolitan Region, within a geographical formation known as a “basin,” as it is surrounded by the Coastal Mountain Range to the west, the majestic Andes Mountains to the east, and bounded to the north and south by mountain ranges extending from the Andes. It is the capital of Chile, with a population of 7,112,808 inhabitants (according to the latest 2017 Census), and was one of the main settlements during the colonial period.

The Metropolitan Region is composed of 52 municipalities, most of which are urban areas; in fact, only 18 are classified as rural.



Competition Venue

The Peñalolén Velodrome, also known as the Santiago Velodrome, is a cycling velodrome located within Peñalolén Park, in the district of Peñalolén, in the city of Santiago, capital of Chile. It was inaugurated in March 2014 as part of the infrastructure built for the 2014 South American Games.

It is considered one of the best velodromes in South America due to its modern facilities and its full compliance with all UCI (Union Cycliste Internationale) standards. The venue is an indoor stadium with a seating capacity of 3,000 spectators.



Velodrome Characteristics:

We recently had the honor of hosting the **UCI Track Cycling World Championships – Santiago 2025**, during which this venue was renovated to achieve the successful results experienced at the event.

The legacy of this World Championship leaves us with the challenge of continuing to work for the development of track cycling at the continental level, with the aim of fostering and developing future world champions in our region.

Currency

The official currency of the Republic of Chile is the **Chilean Peso (CLP)**. Its exchange rate fluctuates against the US dollar, with an approximate rate of **CLP 920 per USD**.

Language

Spanish is the official language of Chile. It coexists with a variety of other languages spoken by different migrant communities that have arrived in the country at various periods of its history, as well as with indigenous languages.


Climate



Medical Services

- Primary medical care provided at the track.
- Transfer to the Military Hospital and nearby clinics, if required.
- Any medical care costs incurred at the official clinic or any other medical facility shall be the responsibility of the rider or their National Federation (**covered through UCI license insurance, where applicable**).
- The Chilean National Cycling Federation and any member of the Organizing Committee shall not be responsible for any medical expenses incurred outside the track.

Event Information

Participants

All riders holding a valid license issued by National Federations that are members of **COPACI**, and only those federations, shall be eligible to participate in the events of the Continental Championships.

The maximum number of participating riders shall be the same for all eligible federations.

UCI Categories

- Elite / U23 Men and Women - According to Article 3.2.001, Junior riders in their last year (born in 2008) are eligible to participate.

Two (2) anti-doping inspectors will be appointed by the International Cycling Union (UCI). This will be carried out according to the current regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI).

LOGISTICS INFORMATION

ACCOMODATION

All accommodation, meal, and transportation expenses for the 2026 Pan American Track Cycling Championships must be covered by the participants.

Santiago is a tourist city with a wide range of hotels, but it is also a city with heavy traffic and considerable distances between points, so choosing a hotel in an unfavorable location can be inconvenient for teams and athletes.

The Organizing Committee, through a partner, offers a logistics service that includes hotel and meals. Rates include transfers between Arturo Merino Benítez Airport and the hotel upon arrival and departure for team members and staff.

Delegations that contract the Organizing Committee's logistics services will also have access to a special lane at the airport for immigration and customs procedures.

If a delegation decides not to use the Organizing Committee's logistics services, it must arrange privately for the transport of bicycles and equipment from the airport to the venue, as well as the transport of the team from the airport to their accommodation.

Reservations must be requested using the logistics pre-booking form attached to this document.

All hotels include:

- ✓ 24/7 Reception
- ✓ Rooms with luggage storage, private bathroom with 24/7 hot water, and complimentary toiletries (shampoo, towels, and soap) provided daily. Cable TV is included. Daily room and bathroom cleaning service.
